Format: 36 Holes (18 each day) of medal play. Play five, count four low scores each day.

Awards:

Team Champion = low team score

Medalist/Player of the Year = low score

All-Tournament/All-TranSouth = Medalist plus next five (six total)

Freshman of the Year = low freshman score

Coach of the Year = coach of winning team

Region XI Tournament: Thirty-six (36) hole tournament, eighteen (18) holes each day. Play five and count the lowest four.

- *Eleven teams* from the Mid-South Conference and the TranSouth Athletic Conference. The region currently has eleven (11) teams which enables each school to participate.
- *Up to three (3) individuals* not on one of these teams can participate in the region golf tournament if their school does not field a complete team.

Rain Plan

- If rain eliminates play on day one the tournament will be 18 holes played on day two.
 - If rain eliminates play on day two the winner will be the highest nationally ranked team in the tournament.
 - If weather, time and course conditions permit the 18 hole completed tournament could be played 9 holes on day one and 9 holes on day two. Every school in the field would need to complete the same 9 holes each day.
